

## SEAFARER'S SCARF

(Please read complete scarf directions before starting)

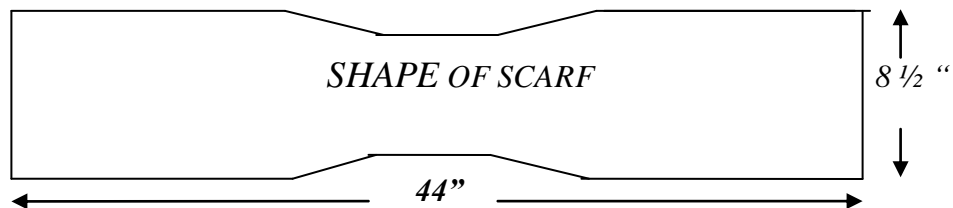
**Material:** 4-Ply knitting yarn (total 7 oz.)

**Needles:** Pair No. 6 --- two panels (Garter Stitch)  
Center ribbed section (K4, Pr)  
Wool needle for joining yarn; finishing garment

**Gauge** 5 sts to inch; 7 rows to inch (Garter Stitch)  
Cast on 40 sts with medium tension.  
K even for 14 inches.  
K4, P4, for 16 inches.  
K even for 14 inches.  
Bind off with medium tension.

**Note:** MEASUREMENT OF COMPLETED SCARF; Width 8 ½ inches (4 inches at narrow middle); and length about 44 inches.

- a) Please adjust size of needle to get above dimensions.
- b) To join yarn from two different bails, splice together or join side of scarf and work in ends along edge.
- c) Please do not join yarn from two different dye lots.
- d) To replace dropped stitch, place right half of loop at front of needle – the side facing you when you work – otherwise stitch will be reversed and pattern interrupted.
- e) When measuring, be sure both panels are the same length, without stretching them to match
- f) It is not necessary to block the Garter Stitch panels. Never block ribbing.
- g) Recommended: Do not start another scarf with left-over yarn unless you are sure there is enough yarn to complete it.
- h) Do not use woolen yarns.
